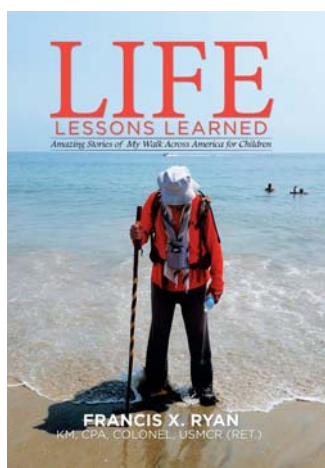

Camino Island by John Grisham

A collection of rare books and manuscripts, a disreputable book dealer on a tropical island, and a woman trying to penetrate the operation. Enjoyable and a departure for Grisham (no lawyers!). Find this book in the library at FIC/GRI or CD/FIC/GRI.

Kill Devil Falls by Brian Klingborg

Marshall Helen Morrissey is sent to the remote mountain village of Kill Devil Falls to arrest a fugitive. The town lives up to its name. A dark and twisted thriller.

Gwendy's Button Box by Stephen King

A short novel about a young girl who is given an odd gift by a strange man. An interesting and thought provoking story.

Miramar Bay by T. Davis Bunn

The Girl Who Knew Too Much by Amanda Quick
Set in glamorous California in the 1930s, a young reporter for a gossip magazine is about to get her first big scoop. But her source has been silenced. Good storytelling.

Two sisters, one living on Nantucket, one on Martha's Vineyard, have been estranged for years. The only thing they have in common is irresponsible behavior. Will Mom's illness change the dynamic? Beach reading.

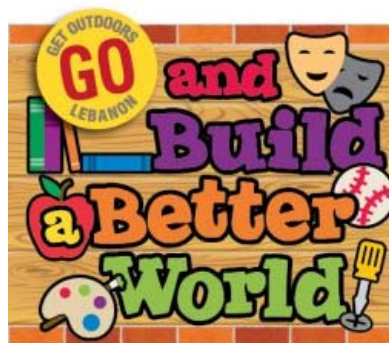
