Beartown by Fredrik Backman

Beartown, Sweden, is long past its glory days. But it still has one thing going for it - its hockey team. An engrossing novel from a master storyteller. Find this book in the library at FIC/BAC.

The Curious Charms of Arthur Pepper by Phaedra Patrick
Sixty-nine year old Arthur, a recent widower, very set in his ways, discovers something in his wife's possessions that sets him off on a life-changing adventure. A sweet and poignant story.

The Barefoot Summer by Carolyn Brown
Kate's husband is dead. She won't miss the scoundrel, nor will his previous wives - the ones he neglected to divorce. A fine mess and an entertaining novel.

When a devastating fire destroys a community in Maine in 1947 (a true event), a woman and her family try to reconstruct their lives. Her husband is presumed dead. A powerful novel.

Venice detective Guido Brunetti, suffering from burnout, vacations on a nearby island. His idyllic vacation ends when his friend goes missing. Probably the best in the series.

Set in the South during the Civil War, a young wife is left to manage a farm in her husband's absence - with tragic consequences. A spellbinding human drama.

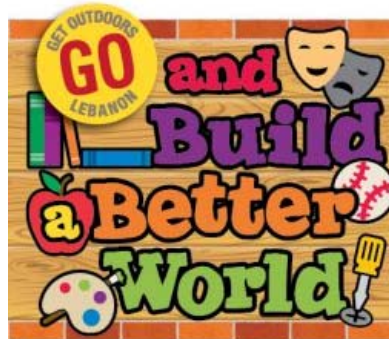

The GO and Be Active! program begins on Monday, June 5th and runs until Monday, August 14th. Copies of the free GO and Be Active! Playbook and rubbing sheet may be picked up at any Lebanon County Library location starting June 5, 2017.

Join children and families from all over Lebanon County this summer in the 2nd annual Get Outdoors (GO) and Be Active! program. Get outdoors and discover the wonder of nature as you hunt for 15 activity posts hidden in parks and along trails in Lebanon County. Children follow clues available in their free GO and Be Active! blueprint to locate each posts. They then make a rubbing of the unique etching plate found at each post as a record of their "find."
