This thought provoking historical novel follows the life of a man before, during, and after the Civil War. It raises questions about the human condition that echo the Book of Job.

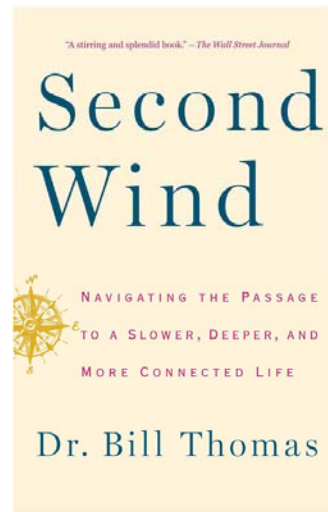
