

Libraries Rock is our state-wide theme. Storytimes and activities will reflect this theme and encourage children to keep reading over the summer months.



Due to financial constraints, delivery of books and other materials between each of the Lebanon County libraries will decrease from five days per week to three days per week effective July 1, 2018. Delivery will take place on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays.

Many factors went into making this decision, including level funding for the Lebanon County Library District and reasonable increases in the cost of delivery. The schedule of Monday, Wednesday, and Friday was agreed upon by the Directors of the libraries in order to have the smallest impact on customer service. Our libraries continue to strive for excellent customer service and fiscal responsibility.
