This **FREE interactive** program is for babies, toddlers, and their parents, grandparents, and caregivers! **Miss Ronice** of Lebanon County Libraries will incorporate her Smart Start Storytime with **The Basics**, five simple and powerful ways you can give your child a great start in life.



The first week of each month, January through May, **free kits** including a book, information on The Basics, the words of the songs used in each session, and sometimes some fun extras will become available at the **Lebanon Community Library** and the **Annvile Free Library**.

How do I join?

How long will each session last?

Each session will last approximately 30 minutes, but feel free to join or leave at any time.

What will the session be like?

Miss Ronice will welcome everyone first. She'll use items like shakers, scarves, drums, and more during her storytime, and she'll share some ideas of common household items you can use at home. She'll talk about The Basics, and ideas for teaching and bonding with your child. At various points during the session, she will unmute participants so you can join in if you want.
