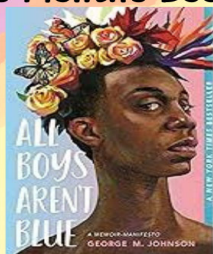

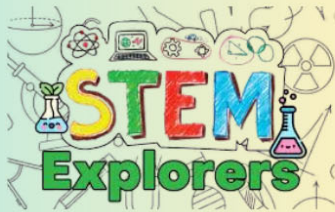

STEM Room



The STEM Room is a fun and engaging space where students explore science, technology, engineering, and math through hands-on play. It features a wide variety of puppets, blocks, LEGOs, and other interactive toys that encourage creativity, problem-solving, and teamwork. By experimenting and building in a playful environment, students develop essential thinking skills that lay the foundation for future learning in STEM fields.

STEM Explorers



The STEM Room is open Thursdays during STEM Explorers and by request when supervised. It features a large collection of puppets, blocks, LEGOs, and other toys. In the summer, it becomes the hub for the Summer Learning Program, where kids ages 2–14 can turn in activity sheets to earn free books and prizes for reading and completing activities.

Paws To Read

Paws to Read is a special program that allows children to practice reading aloud to trained therapy dogs in a relaxed, supportive environment. This program helps build confidence, improve literacy skills, and make reading a fun and positive experience. By providing a



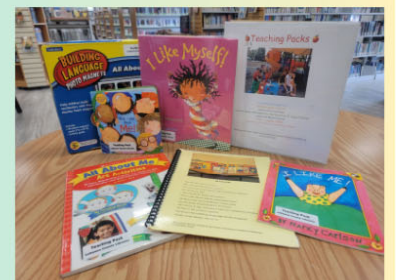
nonjudgmental listener, Paws to Read encourages young readers to develop a love for books while fostering a sense of comfort and achievement.

Reading Packs



Reading Packs are themed tote bags filled with books and a related educational game or toy. They come in three age levels—0–3, 3–5, and 5+—with fun topics like colors and shapes, dinosaurs, outer space, families, and construction.

Teaching Packs



Teaching Packs are themed tote bags designed for classroom use, each containing books, group activities or games, and a resource book for educators. They're perfect for exploring a topic with a group of children in an engaging, hands-on way.
