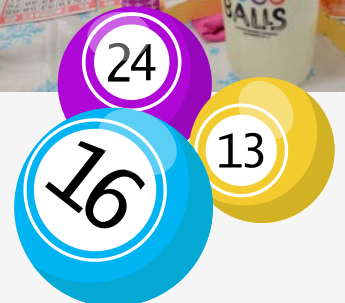
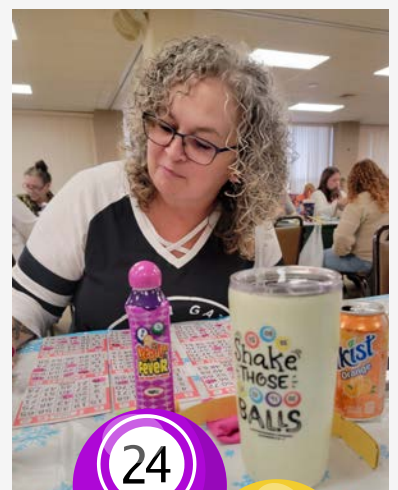


2025 Bingo Sponsorship

The Lebanon Community Library is a vital hub for the residents of Lebanon County, Pennsylvania, providing essential access to technology, literature, media, and community resources for all ages and backgrounds. Serving a diverse community of approximately 65,000, where 28% identify as Hispanic and 12.6% speak a language other than English at home, the library plays a crucial role in bridging cultural and educational gaps. With over 100,000 items in its holdings, the library is committed to fostering lifelong learning, offering free resources that empower patrons to explore their interests and achieve personal growth.

The community has unique needs: while 25% of residents hold a bachelor's degree or higher, 11.3% live in poverty, which underscores the importance of providing equitable access to technology and educational materials. For families and individuals navigating financial challenges, the library is a gateway to essential tools — computers, internet access, educational programs, and career resources — that might otherwise be inaccessible. It also serves as a safe, welcoming space for the 22.4% of the population under 18, nurturing early literacy and educational support for young learners, as well as the 20.8% who are over 65, who benefit from lifelong learning and social connection.

The Lebanon Community Library strengthens the fabric of this dynamic community by ensuring everyone, regardless of background or income, has the opportunity to learn, grow, and connect. Through its offerings, the library not only promotes literacy and education but also fosters a sense of belonging and unity in Lebanon County.

Why Supporting the Lebanon Community Library Matters

In 2024, the library served as a vibrant hub for connection and learning:

- 89,226 visitors walked through our doors
- 52,454 cardholders accessed our catalog of over 77,896 items
- 131,783 items were borrowed by patrons
- 14,770 items loaned to other libraries; 9,999 items borrowed
- 9,578 sessions on public computers and 73,371 sessions on our public WiFi
- 278 programs were hosted, with 4,910 attendees
