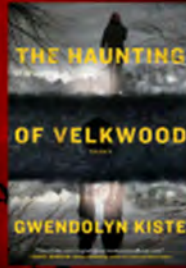

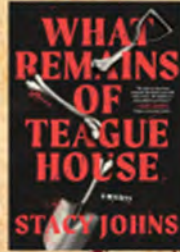

Books To Go offers homebound delivery for Lebanon County residents unable to visit the library due to disability. Simply complete a short form about your reading preferences, and library volunteers will deliver books to your home once a month.

Interlibrary Loans



Interlibrary Loan allows you to borrow books and other materials from libraries outside Lebanon County. If our library doesn't have an item, we can request it from another library, giving you access to a wider range of resources.

Library Cards



Lebanon County residents are eligible for a free Library Card, which provides borrowing privileges at all six public libraries in the county.

To register, visit any of the six libraries and complete a short application. A valid ID and proof of residency are required.

Library Outpost



The Gateway Library at Cornwall Manor is a partner in providing library service throughout the county. An independent library available for in-person visits to Cornwall Manor residents only, they lend their books throughout the county, enhancing the materials available to all.
